Land art	Art made using natural materials.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Nature sculptures that are made in and created from the environment are called land art.
Showcase	Works of art on display.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Some land art lasts a long time. This might be made from earth, stone, wood or living plants. Some will only last a short time. This might be made from leaves, sand, ice and snow.
Work of art	A painting or sculpture created using imagination.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ You can make land art or nature sculptures out of any natural objects.
