

Joan Miró	A famous painter known for painting and sculptures.			
Printmaking	Transferring images onto another surface.			
Magical Realism	Magical events or things in a realistic environment.			
Surrealism	Where an artist uses their imagination, sometimes inspired by dreams.			





Design	An outline, a sketch or a plan.	Sticky knowledge about Joan Miró
Relief printing	A process consisting of cutting or etching a printing surface.	 Joan Miró was from Catalonia in Spain.
Illustration	A picture or diagram that explains or decorates.	 Miró escaped to Majorca in the 1940s.
Symbols	A drawing, shape, or object that represents an idea or object.	 Miró was 90 years old when he died. He created artwork for almost his entire life.
Clay	A natural material that feels like soft, gluey mud.	In 1966, Miró made his first 'monumental sculptures', which were far bigger than any artworks he had created before.
Monumental	Massive and imposing.	 Miró is sometimes said to have created 'automatic drawing.' This is the process of letting your hand draw whatever it wants, without thinking too much about what you are creating.
		 In 1954, Miró received a special award called the 'Venice Bienniale' print making prize.
