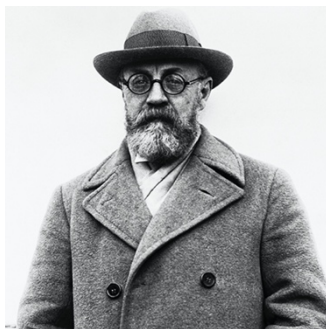

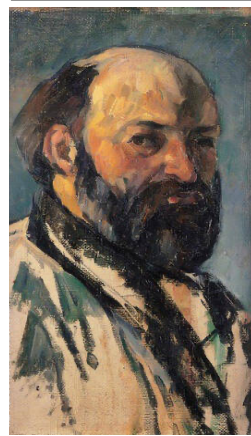
## Subject Specific Vocabulary

<b>Observational drawing</b>	To draw or paint something as accurately as possible.
<b>Pattern</b>	A repeated decorative design.
<b>Blend</b>	When colours are slightly mixed together.
<b>Texture</b>	The way something feels to the touch or looks to the eye. You may use words like rough and smooth to describe texture.
<b>Form</b>	Objects that are 3-dimensional.
<b>Tone</b>	The lightness or darkness of the colour.

## Sticky knowledge about Autumn

- Henri Matisse was born on 31<sup>st</sup> December 1869.
- In 1906, Matisse met Pablo Picasso and they became good friends.
- Cezanne was born into a wealthy family so he never had to worry about money.
- Cezanne painted slowly believing that he needed to truly observe what he was painting before he could capture it with a brushstroke.
- Cezanne was Catholic and religious images often appeared in his early work.
- At the beginning of his career, Matisse focused on painting landscapes and still-lives.
