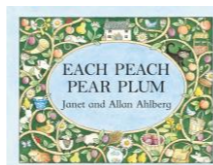
Knowledge and skills I will be learning this half term



Literacy

Knowledge and Skills

- I can 'Write' by repeating one mark or a series of repeated shapes.
- I can answer open questions.
- I talk to my partner when the teacher asks a question.
- I can have conversations about the stories we are reading, using the new words I have learnt.
- I am starting to know the difference between reading and writing.
- I know the story title 'Each Peach Pear Plum' and can say some things that happen in the story.



Communication and Language

Knowledge and Skills

- I can confidently start, and hold, a conversation with my friends and adults in nursery using simple sentences.
- I can remember words I have been taught and use them when I talk.
- I can sing two of the rhymes from the Brentnall Poetry Curriculum: Row, Row, Row your Boat & Baa Baa Black Sheep.



Physical Development

Knowledge and Skills

- I can start to select my own resources to carry out a plan.
- I can have a good go at putting on my own coat, with a bit of help if I need it.
- I can take off my own coat.
- I can kick a ball.
- I can have a good go at riding a trike or a scooter.
- I can have a good go at using a knife and fork when I eat.



Expressive Art and Design

Knowledge and Skills

- I can have a good go at playing musical instruments in different ways like fast and slow.
- I can experiment with mixing paint and I recognise this makes a different colour.
- I can draw a simple picture, where shapes represent objects.



Understanding the World

Knowledge and Skills

- I can talk about my own family, using photos to help me if I need them.
- I can talk about how fruits taste and smell, using the new words I have been taught.
- I know there is a country called Africa that is far away.
- I know some places in Africa look different from where we live.
- I can talk about the clothes you wear when it is cold and I am starting to learn the word 'Winter.'
- I notice that ice melts and I use the word 'melt' to describe what is happening.

- I can use the toilet with very few accidents.
- I can have a good go at brushing my teeth.
- I can wash my hands, with a bit of help if I need it.
- I can follow the class routines and rules, with a bit of help if I need it.
