Attendance / Punctuality

Helping at home:

Class Dojo In the first few weeks of Nursery, we will introduce our reward system – 'Dojos.'

Dojos are points that are earned by following class rules, using manners, trying your best with learning, being a good friend, etc. Each child has their own exciting Dojo character and they will see they points they collect on the board. There are even prizes for the child with the most Dojos at the end of the week!

Focus Children

Each week we will focus on 3 children to record examples of learning opportunities and teacher/pupil engagement on paper. These children will bring a letter home to invite parents to share photos or events that we can also record and add to their learning file.

Reminders

- All children need a bag with spare clothes including socks to be kept in school.
- All children should have a pair of wellies to be kept in school.
- Children can bring in a water bottle to keep at school.
- If your child has asthma, we need an extra inhaler to be kept at school in case we need to administer.
- Pupils should all be in correct uniform, this includes black school shoes.
