## Brentnall Academy School Uniform

### Rational:

We believe that uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school and instils a sense of pride in its pupils. Uniform also supports positive behaviour and discipline; encourages identity with and support for, the school ethos and ensures pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome and free from social pressures to dress in a particular way.

### The Brentnall Academy Uniform is as follows:

- Maroon sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo
- White shirt
- School tie
- Grey school skirt / Grey school trousers/grey school shorts
- Plain grey, maroon or white tights
- Black leggings may be worn in place of tights with a grey skirt
- Yellow or maroon gingham summer dress
- Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers. ***Please note that if trainers are being worn, they must be completely black with no other colours visible.***

### Children in Year 6

- White shirt
- School tie
- School blazer
- V neck school jumper or cardigan (Optional)
- Grey skirt/ Grey school trousers/grey school shorts
- Plain grey, maroon or white tights
- Yellow or maroon gingham summer dress
- Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers. ***Please note that if trainers are being worn, they must be completely black with no other colours visible.***

### Indoor PE Kit

- Black shorts
- White T-Shirt
- Bare feet

### Outdoor PE Kit

- Black/grey tracksuit/ Grey school hoodie
- Plain White T-Shirt/Grey plain Sweatshirt
- Outdoor Trainers

### Additional Expectations

- A coat is needed for play times

- We are a halo hair school and respect cultural hair styles, if unsure please ask.
- Long hair must be tied back for PE and any other activities where it may pose a risk
- No acrylic nails or nail varnish
- Cultural or religious head covers may be worn please ensure these are in line with the school colours.
- Children must not wear any jewellery other than stud earrings
- No make up
